## **Grade 5 Human Body Systems**

Make something that a primary class could use and enjoy while they learn about human body systems. Use language and ideas that primary learners will not be overwhelmed by. Include information about what can go wrong (e.g. disease or other problems) with your system.

Some examples of how to make this work:

- create a story for a simple picture book that is fun to read but also teaches your system and then you could leave it with a class
- create a "Superhero" character that is representative of the whole system (e.g. Brainiac Man!) and feature your superhero in a drama that entertains but also teaches about the body system you studied
- You could create a fun board game that is fun but also teaches about your system

**MARKING**: Group Mark: Your group will be assigned a mark for creating and presenting what you made. (We will "workshop" present them in our own class to test your ideas out) **Individual Mark**: You should be able to describe in one or paragraph what your specific research contribution was (e.g. I found the website "abc" which helped us understand how things work together.... etc)

Final Mark: A combination of the first two marks
